Eligibility for a scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 shall be awarded and limited to the current 2025-2026 graduating high school seniors. This scholarship applies to all College, Trade, and Technical continue educational institutions.

This award will be given on the basis on the following:

- ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE or/GPA
- SCHOOL EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES
- COMMUNITY-ORIENTED SERVICE
- RELIGIOUS AND/OR VOLUNTEER ACTVITIES
- RECOMMENDATIONS BY SCHOOL COUNSELOR/OFFICIAL OR MEMBER OF TEACHING STAFF
- STUDENT WRITTEN ESSAY
- VERIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY

All scholarships are in the form of certificates and issued upon the enrollment of the student in an undergraduate course in an accredited college, university, trade or technical school. Upon receipt of verification of enrollment from the students chosen institution, the Ahrens Alumni Association Scholarship Committee will issue a check directly to the institution to be applied to the student's account. This scholarship shall not be used for any purposes other than tuition. Please note, there will be no exceptions to the disbursement of this award.

ENCLOSE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WITH THIS FORM:

- 1. A current picture of yourself (at least 5x7 suitable for publication). This picture will not be returned.
- 2. The Statement of Eligibility properly completed and notarized. (see page 6)
- 3. A copy of your high school transcript containing all of your junior and senior semesters. Transcript <u>must</u> contain GPA, credits, and days missed during the senior year.
- 4. A brief summary of your school, community-oriented and/or religious activities and accomplishments, your educational objectives, and any additional information that you believe qualifies you for this award.
- 5. A letter of endorsement from at least one of the following: School Counselor or Official, or member of the teaching staff from your high school (on school letterhead or notarized).
- 6. An essay of 500 words or LESS describing your personal and educational goals for the future, your need for financial assistance, if any, and any personal challenges you may anticipate in furthering your education. Grammar, punctuation and content will be considered. It is suggested applicant should have the essay previewed by a school counselor, teacher or member of the school staff.

All information will be kept strictly confidential, except for essay and 5x7 picture, which we may want for publication in our newsletter. The entire Scholarship Application Form and required attachments MUST be received by the Ahrens Alumni Association Scholarship Committee no later than close of business on **April 1, 2026**.
